

Glidden Community Learning Center

The Glidden Community Learning Center is a grant funded program that provides academic support and enrichment opportunities to students at the Chequamegon School District. Students are able to participate in a variety of capacities to help support their physical, emotional, and academic growth.

Programs

Morning Program

The library at the Glidden Campus is open at 6:30 a.m. Students may report to school during this time and go directly to the library. During this time, they may choose an enrichment activity or receive homework support from the staff member. Students will be dismissed in time to eat breakfast prior to boarding the shuttle bus to the Park Falls Campus or the school day in Glidden. Chequamegon School District students of all grades and both campuses are welcome to attend this program.

After-School Program

❑ Snack & Enrichment

- ❑ **School Dismissal - 3:50** - During this time of the After-School Program, students will be given a healthy snack and the opportunity for physical activity and social enrichment activities. Students of all grades are welcome during this time.

❑ Organization/Study Skills

- ❑ **3:50 - 4:00** - During this time of the After-School Program, students will meet with their assigned tutor and organize materials and assignments. Middle School/High School students may meet individually with the student advocate in order to discuss upcoming assignments or missing work. Elementary students may also use this time to learn organizational and study skills.

❑ Homework Support & Intervention

- ❑ **4:00 - 5:00** - During this time of the After-School Program, students will work on daily assignments or homework as well as have the opportunity to gain extra instruction in areas of which they need further academic support.

❑ Enrichment

- ❑ **5:00 - 5:30** - During this time of the After-School Program, students will have the opportunity to participate in enrichment activities such as: Technology Exploration, Imaginative Play, Board Games, Buddy Reading, Literature Exploration, and Healthy Living Activities.

****NOTE: Elementary students** enrolled in specific days of the After-School program (Not Morning) will be expected to stay on those days unless a note or parent phone call is made to the office or the child's teacher.

Middle School/High School students will be responsible for knowing if they are attending the program each day. A staff member will not be monitoring students who decide to go home after-school as opposed to staying at the program. Please discuss your expectations of attending the program with your child.
